

# Donation gift guide

Thanks to our incredible community, we can bring joy to children in hospital with special gifts for birthdays, Christmas, milestones and bad days. Your donation can lift the spirits of children and their families during the toughest times, and we are so thankful for your kindness.



## Items we welcome

### Babies and toddlers (0-24 months)

Easy to clean items such as rattles, stacking blocks, things that light up and flip, push and pull toys and baby books (black and white board books, cloth books and crinkle books).

### Younger children (3-7 years)

Plastic animals, dinosaurs, cars, trucks, individual dolls (Barbies, baby dolls), Polly Pocket, Little Live Pets, Playmobil, role play and picture books.

### Older children (8-12 years)

Action figures, construction kits (Meccano, Engino, Technic), remote control cars, chapter books, jewellery making, puzzle books, craft and colouring books.

### Teenagers (13+ years)

Gift vouchers (max \$30 value), Rubik's Cubes and educational puzzles, Bluetooth speakers, headphones, makeup and mindfulness books.

### All ages

Lego (Duplo to Adults), licensed products (Bluey, Disney, Marvel, DC, Harry Potter, Pokemon, Squishmallow), hand-sized toys, sensory toys, Play-doh (28g and 84g pot sizes), pencils, pens, crayons, card games and boardgames.

### Emergency clothing and toiletries

Not all hospital trips are expected and sometimes families need help with the bare necessities.

- **Clothing for all ages and sizes** including adults – comfortable clothing such as t-shirts, shorts, leggings and underwear.
- **Toiletries** such as individually packaged toothbrushes, mini toothpaste, low-scent roll-on deodorant, travel size shampoo, conditioner and body wash, sanitary products, hand cream and lip balm.



## Donation restrictions

To keep our children safe and comply with hospital policies, there are some items we unfortunately cannot accept, including:

- Second-hand toys and clothing and anything not recently purchased
- Items containing button batteries
- Political, controversial or religious items
- Items with sharp edges
- Toys that depict violence or weapons (for example: toy guns, Nerf guns, swords)
- Food, toxic items, latex or scented items
- Knitted blankets.

Our toys are often delivered to children confined to their rooms or wards. When selecting your donations, please also be mindful of the size and use.
