Safety Guidelines

- All materials used must be new and previously unused to ensure items meet infection control guidelines.
- No embellishments of **any kind** – this includes buttons, beads, charms, ribbons, safety eyes, so on.
- Please ensure all loose threads and stuffing have been secured properly during the crafting process.
- Avoid using scented or treated yarns, as fragrances and chemicals may trigger allergic reactions in sensitive patients.
- Material designs and patterns must be child-appropriate.
- For crocheted and / or knitted donations, items must be made using a tight stitch or small hook to reduce the risk of snagging.
